Principal's Report - Mike Benoit

•Recently attended a regional state meeting of Principals and heard about a lecturer from "Personal Protection Services". The lecturer speaks with the assistance of his two children and wife. They address how to be responsible digital citizens, hazards kids should look out for, and how to be aware of them. The speaker was given excellent marks from two of the Principals Mr. Benoit met with.

Core 24 and Highly Capable program were reviewed. Notes from the meeting available on the VPO website (link on the HRMS site under Parents/Community tab- VPO)

Highly Capable criteria will be changing. John Hellwich to outline changes at a presentation tonight at Henderson Bay High School 6pm. Specific changes that impact 6th, 7th and 8th Graders.

- 1) Top 4% of kids evaluated mainly with CoGAT scores will be given the opportunity to attend self contained classrooms at Kopachuck or KPMS.
